Changes made since Version 7.1F Release:

- 1. **DMX-1000 Zaxcom Source Assignment Updating** A problem has been fixed that prevented the Source Assignment Table from being downloaded to the mixer after exiting from the Super Edit Assignment page.
- 2. **Sony MXP-390** We have added a timing constant to fix BVB previews in the MXP-390 mixer, and to minimize the chance of the MXP-390 falling asleep.
- **3.** Sony SX New protocols are available for Sony DNW-A25, DNW-A75, and DNW-A100 SX format VTRs.
- **4. Sony SX** If a DNW was the only 4 channel VTR in a program, the 4 channel audio control was incorrect. This has been corrected.
- **5. DVCPro** Synchronizing problems with the AJ-D650/750/950 series VTRs have been resolved.
- 6. **Sony Digital Switcher** Super Edit now uses the Black cross-point defined in the Assignment page for the AUX Bus preview Black (for BVB & VBV)
- 7. Sony Digital Switchers X-PEG trims have been added for the Sony Switchers.
- 8. **Sony D75** An interface is now available for the BVW-D75 Allowing for forward variable speeds up to 300%.
- 9. **Tape Timer** The TAPE TIMER now jams Drop Frame TC correctly for the DVCPro and DNW VTRs
- 10. **Leitch Xpress** A new interface is available which allows the Leitch Xpress 12X router to be used as a Preview Switcher.
- 11. **Slaves** Fixed a problem wherein if a DVCPro VTR was the second and /or third member of a Slave set with a BVW as the first member the editor would lock up.
