ESAM II - PGM bus monitor mode

Introduction

This document describes a custom interface between Super Edit and the Graham-Patten DESAM mixers using the ESAM II protocol. While we expect this modification will work with most other ESAM II protocol mixers, they would first have to be tested.

Application

Under standard ESAM II control, the monitor output of the mixer is switched to the Internal or "Source" bus whenever the R-VTR or a Source VTR is selected. In this way, either the R-VTR or the Source VTR is heard when selected at the editor.

In this new mode, when the R-VTR is selected the monitor is switched to the Source bus so that only the R-VTR is heard. When a Source is selected, the monitor output is switched to the Mixer (PGM) output bus so that the output of all open faders is heard.
